

SCRIBBLES TO SCRIPT

An opportunity for children from preschool (prewriting) through elementary (cursive) school to work with an **occupational therapist** and participate in multi-sensory fine motor, visual-motor, and visual-perceptual activities to learn pre-writing skills, proper letter formation, and age-appropriate handwriting skills using the *Handwriting Without Tears®* program. Help to reinforce learning and make writing fun!

Preschool

This class focuses on the development of prewriting skills, such as pencil grasp, coloring skills, imitation and copying of lines and shapes, and basic introduction to letters.

Kindergarten

The goal of this class is to review letter recognition and to learn proper formation of capital manuscript letters.

1st- 2nd Grade

This class focuses on the proper formation of lower case manuscript letters.

Cursive

Reviews proper letter formation and focuses on letter placement, spacing and legibility.

SOCIAL BUTTERFLIES

Children between the ages of 4 & 12 have the opportunity to become social butterflies by engaging in fun non-challenging tabletop and movement-based activities. The highly therapeutic classes will be overseen by a speech & language pathologist and/or an OT.

Skills taught include turn taking, topic maintenance, asking appropriate questions, following non-verbal cues, and using manners. 45-minute sessions held once weekly.

SPORTS 1 STEP AT A TIME

An opportunity for children to work with a **physical therapist** and have an introduction into several fall/winter sports in a non-competitive small group setting.

TYPING WHIZKIDS

An opportunity for children to work with an **occupational therapist** to learn efficient keyboarding/typing skills, including key location and finger placement, speed and accuracy.

- All programs are offered 1 x per week, for 45 minutes, from October – January.
- Our programs and/or group therapy sessions are a great alternative to individual therapy. They give children the opportunity to address key developmental areas in structured but busier environments that are more reflective of typical real-life home and school situations
